With the exception of five Hon. Members of Parliament who went on official assignment, Mr. Speaker ordered that the voting be conducted out of a total number of 141 Hon. Members, two-thirds of which is 94 Members.

The Clerk-at-the-Table, **Fatmata Bintu Weston**, commenced the roll call of members for voting.

Members who contributed to the vibrant debate, the media for a live coverage of the proceedings, members at the gallery and the staff of Parliament for a job well done.
