XII. CLARIFICATION BY MR. SPEAKER ON THE NOTICE OF MOTION

The **Rt. Hon. Speaker** at this juncture explained the relevance of S.O. 18 that it is the procedure that must be followed for the *Laying of Papers and Constitutional and Statutory Instruments*. He continued by quoting S.O. 18 (1) that reads “**the laying of papers, treaties, agreements and Constitutional and Statutory Instruments involves the delivery in the office of the Clerk of sufficient copies thereof for distribution to Members of Parliament.**” The Rt. Hon. Speaker made further clarification to the House that S.O. 25 only deals with *Notice of Motions*, which was exactly what **Hon. Daniel B. Koroma** was trying to do.

XIII. RULING BY MR. SPEAKER

On quoting the above S.Os. The Rt. Hon. Speaker ruled that the Hon. Member is out of time to give notice of motion to debate the Constitutional Instruments no. 64 and 65 respectively that was laid on the Table of the House earlier during the sitting.
