PASSAGE OF MOTION

**GOVERNMENT MOTION:**

**THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION**

**BE IT RESOLVED:**

That this Honourable House ratifies the following Conventions which were signed on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1981 and 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1993 respectively and laid on the table of House on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2004

- (i) CONVENTION ON PROHIBITIONS OR RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF CERTAIN CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS WHICH MAY BE DEEMED TO BE EXCESSIVELY INJURIOUS OR TO HAVE INDISCRIMINATE EFFECTS (WITH ITS FIVE PROTOCOLS) CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 10<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 1980
- (ii) CONVENTION ON THE PROHIBITION OF THE DEVELOPMENT, PRODUCTION, STOCKPILING AND USE OF CHEMICAL WEAPONS AND ON THEIR DESTRUCTION

PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY A COLLECTION OF VOICES THIS FIFTEENTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD TWO THOUSAND AND FOUR.
