In view of the above, the Parliament of Sierra Leone is inviting the presence of the International Community, Development Partners, Civil Society Organizations, and the General Public to witness Monday's proceedings that relate exclusively to the establishment of Commissions of Inquiry, with a view of investigating the conduct of the immediate past Government, from 2007 to April 2018.
