Hon. Dr. Bernadette Lahai – As a female Member of Parliament, she expressed her concern on a defamatory statement made by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers (Const. 89 – Pujehun Dist.)** on F.M. 98.1 that very morning, 30th June, 2016, that a female Member of Parliament travelling to Brussels, made a statement that the leadership of Parliament were on the verge of presenting a bill that would eliminate certain people from contesting the presidential election. She requested to know the particular female Hon. Member that made that statement, to reduce the dilemma among the female Members which might lead to security threat.
