VI. STATEMENT BY MR. SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker agreed with the common essence of the suggestions made by the Majority and the Minority Leaders with regard to the need for parliamentary assurance that committee recommendations and the commitments of ministers are duly implemented. He, however, parted company with the idea in the Strategic Plan, adopted by the Minority Leader, of setting up additional monitoring committees to obtain the said-assurances. Rather, on the side of the Majority Party Leader's dissatisfaction with the present diffused state of the multiplicity of existing committees, his standpoint was that under the framework of their mandates, the oversight functions of the already existing committees were neither restrictive nor exhaustive in that they could correctly elicit the required assurances until a Committee on Assurances is instituted.

The Minister responded to the issues raised and moved again its ratification.
