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1. Prayers were read by *Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk)*.

2. **Suspension of S.O. 5 (2):**

The suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 10:50 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Neneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. **The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Monday 20th December, 2021:**

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Monday 20th December, 2021 was moved by **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District** and adopted by the House.

4. **Mr. Speaker's Announcement:**

- (d) **Financing Agreement (Inclusive and Sustainable Growth Development Policy Financing) between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and International Development Association.**



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6. Government Motions:

(A) The Minister of Energy:

The Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon The Minister of Energy.

The Minister of Energy, **Mr. Timothy Kabba**, moved the motion as follows.

“Be it resolved: That this Honourable House hereby ratifies the following agreement which was laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 16th December 2021:”

Amended and Restated Power Purchase Agreement Relating to the 148.5 mw Freetown Generation Project in the Republic of Sierra Leone.

The Minister of Energy, **Alhaji Kanja Sesay**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification.

Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.

The Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon The Minister of Trade and Industry.

The Minister of Trade and Industry, **Dr. Edward Hinga Sandi**, moved the motion as follows.

"Be it resolved: That this Honourable House hereby ratifies the following agreement which was laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 16th December 2021:"

Joint Venture Agreement between the Sierra Leone State Lottery Company Limited ("SLSLC"), THE Government of Sierra Leone (Represented by the National Commission for Privatisation ("NCP") and Accord Logistics for the Establishment of Gaming and Betting Industry in Sierra Leone.

The Minister of Trade and Industry, **Dr. Edward Hinga Sandi**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification.

Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.

7. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 12:00 p.m.

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The Leader of NGC in Parliament, **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella of Constituency 062, Kambia District**, rose on S.O. 34 and stated that **Hon. Lahai Marah** is a professional accountant, and therefore the House should pay keen attention to the educative issues he had raised. He reminded the House that he had once been a Minister of Trade upon which he had managed state lottery. He stated that some of them were wondering why suddenly an agreement of the said nature should come before the House without going through a Select Committee. He said that they did not like being bamboozled and railroaded. He referenced the provision of S.O. 65 that was recited by Mr. Speaker on the previous day sitting. He moved a motion for the said agreement to be sent to a Select Committee for proper examination.

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**, rose on S.O. 34 and stated that he had earlier had discussions with Mr. Speaker to accommodate other items on the Order Paper. He said he believed that the House had had a common understanding of putting another item on the Order Paper notwithstanding the provision of S.O. 65 that was recited by Mr. Speaker. He made reference to the Government Motion by the Minister of Energy that had been ratified on that day's sitting. He then said that the Government Motion by the Minister of Trade and Industry on that day's Order Paper should not be an exception because there was no amendment made on the Order Paper.

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 12:20 p.m. to have consultation with the Leader of NGC, the Leader of Opposition and the Leader of Government Business.

The House resumed at 12:40 p.m.

After the consultation, **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella of Constituency 062, Kambia District** stood again and tendered his apologies to the House for the rancour over the said Government Motion by the Minister of Trade and Industry.

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban**, also joined the Leader of N.G.C to apologize to the House for the unfortunate happening and asked that the said item that brought about the controversy should be deferred to a future date.
