About this Factsheet

This Fact sheet provides an analysis on the parliamentary innings in respect of all Members of Parliament in the current 5th Parliament of the Second Republic of Sierra Leone. Within the parliamentary context, MPs take up their parliamentary innings once they are elected or nominated to serve in Parliament. The number of innings for a Member of Parliament depends on the number of times one is elected or nominated to take his or her parliamentary seat in the House of Parliament. The higher the number of MPs that are not able to make their 2nd inning, demonstrates a high turnover rate, while the higher the number of MPs making their 2nd, 3rd or 4th innings indicates a low turnover rate in any Parliament.

The relevant details regarding the current innings served by the 146 MPs in the Sierra Leone Parliament is contained in this factsheet. The information in this factsheet further reveals an analysis on a party and representation basis.

Parliamentary Innings analysis of Members of Parliament

116 of our current Members of Parliament (MPs) are making their **1st** inning within the Parliament of Sierra Leone. This represents **79.4%** of MPs in the House of Parliament. **22** MPs are making their **2nd** inning, **6** their **3rd** and only **2** now within their **4th** inning in Parliament. **SLPP** has the highest number of MPs making their 1st inning in Parliament. They are **49** in number and this represents **42.2%** of MPs within this category. **APC** has the highest numbers of MPs making their 2nd inning in Parliament. They are **12** in number and this represents **54.5%** of MPs within this category.
