THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER OF JUSTICE TO BRIEF PARLIAMENT ON ALL COMPLIANCES AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REPORT OF THE PUBLIC ACCOUNTS COMMITTEE ON THE AUDITOR

GENERAL'S REPORT ON THE MANAGEMENT OF EBOLA FUNDS, MAY – OCTOBER, 2014.

The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice briefed Parliament on the above subject matter.

Deputy Speaker

Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah's query of the response of the Ministry to the decision of the House on the PAC's recommendation elicited an apology from the Minister. The Deputy Speaker then asked for a letter from the Ministry to supersede the unacceptable one of 27th October, 2015.

Hon. Ansumana J. Kaikai – asked that, for the information of Members, the said letter of 27th October, 2015 be read out in the Chamber. The Minister did, bringing out the following erroneous position:

- 1) From a limited perspective where it did not have full information on the plenary's approval of the recommendations of the P.A.C, the thrust of the letter challenged the P.A.C. for arrogating to itself a penal jurisdiction. The Minister therefore apologized because the Public Service Commission endorsed the recommendations of Parliament, a development that unfortunately was not communicated to him.

Hon. Chernor R.M Bah — Stressed that the recommendations are not from the PAC but were recommendations from the House at plenary.
