**V. STATEMENT BY MR. SPEAKER:**

**Mr. Speaker** informed the House that although the debate on the Kenya visit had been concluded following the motion, there was need for further deliberations in Committee Room 1 on some contentious issues that were raised and therefore discussions should be done in camera.
