**Second Reading:**

The Chief Minister (**Dr. David Moinina Sengeh**) moved that the Bill entitled **"The National Security and Central Intelligence Act, 2025"** be read the Second Time. He presented the objects and reasons of the Bill to the House and again moved that the Bill be read the Second Time.
