**X. STATEMENT BY THE MAJORITY PARTY LEADER AND LEADER OF GOVERNMENT BUSINESS, HON. S.B.B. DUMBUYA:**

**Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya** - informed Members that now that the Sessional Select Committees have been constituted he would like to call on the Minority Party Leader and other senior Members of Parliament from the Opposition, to engage and brief their Members about the work of Parliamentary Committees.

He added that the same would be done with Members of Parliament from their Party. Further, he informed the House that the Clerk of Parliament would be organizing a General orientation workshop for Members of Parliament that would cover the work of Committees, which he said are the microcosm of Parliament.

**XI. ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE HON. S.B.B. DUMBUYA:**

**Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya** - informed the House that the five day Presidential debate would commence on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 and would end on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 after which the debate on the budget speech would follow.

**XII. STANDING ORDER 23 (S.O. 23):**

1. **Hon. Komba E. Koedoyoma** - Informed Members about a fire incident in his Constituency which engulfed the entire village that was razed to the ground, and

further appealed to Members of Parliament, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO's) and other Institutions for help.

2. **Hon. P.C. Bai Kurr Kanagbaro Sanka III** - Informed the House about the poor quality of the communication system with regard to the services provided by the companies, especially Airtel, whose services to users are most of the time disrupted during the communication process .

He gave notice of a motion on that matter.

Mr. Speaker however, advised that the matter should be brought to the relevant Committee.

3. **Hon. Alimamy G. Kargbo** - Disclosed that fire disasters in the Western Area are not effectively handled by the Fire Force, and called on the Committee on Internal Affairs to look into that issue.
4. **Hon. Alusine Marah** - Informed the House that on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2013, his car was burnt down completely in the Western Area.
5. **Hon. Dr. Matthew M.T. Teambo** - Commended Members of Parliament for adhering to the Parliamentary dress code.

He further advised Members especially new ones, to familiarize themselves with Standing Order 77 (S.O. 77) which deals with absenteeism, privileges and rights.

6. **Hon. Frederick S. Sourie** - Disclosed that he went to Kono and had discussion with the people and that the road leading to Kono is in a deplorable condition.
7. **Hon. Mohamed Kamara** - Expressed concern about the spate of armed robberies, and cholera outbreak at Calaba Town.
8. **Hon. Abdul Salaam Kanu** - Reiterated that in his capacity as Deputy Chairman of the Committee on Local Government, he would do his level best to tackle and address challenges he would be faced with.
9. **Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya** - Announced the death of the father of Hon. Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 105. He further reminded the Leadership of the S.L.P.P. and A.P. C. Parties about the meeting with the Minister of Finance and Economic Development, Bank Governor and others at 2:00 p.m. in the Conference room, and added that the Chairman of the Committee on Finance should be in readiness to discuss the issue of

payment of gratuities and salaries to Members of Parliament for November, 2012.
