IX. FELICITATIONS BY MR. SPEAKER

The Hon. Speaker extended his felicitations to the newly-approved presidential nominees and stated that they are suitably qualified for their various positions. He specifically mentioned the newly-approved Chairman, Board of Directors of Rokel Commercial Bank Limited, **Mr. Buffy Bailor**, whom he had been acquainted with and believed would be able to make a difference in terms of performance in the bank. He also reiterated what the Acting Leader of the Opposition stated about NATCOM. He concluded by wishing them well on their various appointments.

- X. **Hon. Momoh Bockarie** – As a Member of the Human Right Committee, the Hon. Member raised concern over the sudden death of a twelve years old boy who went to celebrate his birthday at the Freetown Amusement Park and was found dead by drowning at the swimming pool with broken bones. He drew the attention of the House to the process of investigation which he considered to be in a slow pace and unsatisfactory. He informed the House that the suspect in custody, who works at the Amusement Park, had been released and that the Park had already resumed its normal operations irrespective of the fatal incident that occurred. **The Hon. Member moved a motion for the temporary closure of the entire park to complete pending investigation.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh (Const. 013 – Kenema Dist.)**
