VI. MR SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker drew attention to a provision in the Finance Bill 2019, which proposed the creation of a Procurement Directorate. It was agreed to expunge it on the ground that it duplicated or derogated from the functions of the National Public Procurement Authority. The Hon. Speaker asked the Minister whether or not any allocation has been made in that regard by the Ministry of Finance.

RESPONSE BY THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF FINANCE – That the Procurement Directorate within the Ministry of Finance is charged with the responsibility of ensuring the day to day procurement processes that are undertaken within the various MDAs. She distinguished between the Directorate under the Ministry of Finance and the National Procurement Authority clarifying their functions by explaining that N.P.P.A. is the apex regulator as they are the custodian of the Public Procurement Act. They regulate and monitor compliance with the 2016 Public Procurement Act.

VII. MR. SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker again asked the Deputy Minister of Finance to assure the House for the record that the procurement unit in the Ministry of Finance would in no way derogate from the functions of the NPPA.

RESPONSE BY THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF FINANCE – She responded by assuring the House that there would be no derogation of functions of the N.P.P.A. She also said that the Ministry of Finance will ensure that the N.P.P.A. maintains its role under the 2016 Public Procurement Act. She concluded by saying the Ministry of Finance would also ensure that the Procurement Officers within the various MDAs process the different contracts within the purview of the Aforementioned Act. She also positively assured that the House that the

procurement unit within the Ministry will not do any function that would duplicate the function of the NPPA.

Hon. Hassan A. Sessay (Const. 050 – Tonkolili Dist.)(Acting Leader of the Opposition) – Reminded the House that the issue had been dealt with and expunged in the House of Parliament during the passage of the Finance Act 2019 so therefore its re-emergence implies a hidden agenda which needed a comprehensive explanation. He insisted that what had been done by Parliament cannot be undone.

Hon. Francis A. Kaisamba – Argued that the functions of both entities are different and that there is no way one could perform the responsibility of the other.

IX. Mr. Speaker

For the edification of Members and the general public, Mr. Speaker drew the attention of the House that there was a provision in the Bill entitled, The Finance Bill, 2019, Section 27, of which sought to establish a procurement directorate within the Ministry of Finance but it had been agreed in the course of the debate in the House to expunge that Section from the Bill. The Hon. Speaker justified the reason for it being expunged since it was perceived that the directorate might derogate from the functions of the N.P.P.A. He encouraged Hon. Members to look into the Budget Estimate and expunge the word **Directorate** from the Estimates. The Hon. Speaker concluded by stating that the existence of a procurement unit in the Ministry will be tolerated only along the lines as for other ministries but not anything like “*Directorate*”.

Hon. Lahai Marah (Const. 042 – Falaba Dist.) – referred the House to page 248 of the 2019 Budget Estimate and reminded the House that he had earlier moved a motion for the phrase *Procurement Directorate* to be replaced with “*procurement Unit or Department*”.

X. RULING BY MR. SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker ruled that the Word Directorate in the estimate be replaced with unit.

Hon. Lahai Marah (Const. 042 – Falaba Dist.) – raised concern over the budget line and the role of the Budget Officer who is being posted to the Ministry from NPPA.

Hon. Sidie M. Tunis – Argued that monies allocated had nothing to do with the nomenclature and that the Ministry of Finance is the hub of all Government ministries and should not be in comparison with any other.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Lamin Yansaneh**, commenced roll call of MDAs in the report of Committee of Supply 2.

Mr. Speaker ordered that decisions would only be taken on MDAs that were present in the Chamber.
