1. Prayers were read by **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma (Table Clerk)**.
2. **Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:30 a.m.**
The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:30 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh of Constituency 092, Bonthe District** and approved by the House.
3. **Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 15th June, 2021:**
The motion for the adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Tuesday 15th June, 2021** was moved by **Hon. Ambrose Maada Lebby of Constituency 083, Bo District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** and adopted by the House with an amendment.
4. **Mr. Speaker's Announcements:**
 - (i) The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House about the death of the wife of **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District**. He further informed the House that her burial ceremony would be held on the 21st of June 2021 at 4:00 p.m. He asked all to rise and observe a minute of silence, and he recited the following prayer as quoted: "May the gentle soul of the deceased rest in perfect peace and may Allah grant her husband and other family members the fortitude to bear this great loss."
 - (ii) He informed the House that the whips on both sides of the aisle were not doing their job very well. He said that he would like to see some improvements in their performance. He took the opportunity to commend the following Hon. Members for their prompt attendance:

- (iii) The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that COVID-19 was spiking again. He, therefore, stated that the House should adopt a voluntarily policy of masking up. He made the following declaration as quoted: “ that all Hon. Members, members of the press gallery and all visitors will not be allowed into the Well unless they are properly masked up starting from the 21st of June 2021.” He informed Hon. Members about the new guidelines that had been promulgated by the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone on COVID-19. He said that he as Mr. Speaker had taken his two shots of the vaccines, and he highly recommended that all Hon. Members should consider taking their vaccines for the good and safety of themselves and their families.
- (iv) The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, reminded the House about the use of the ‘Title’- Honourable. He stated that a ruling was on its way on that particular issue.

Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella of Constituency 062, Kambia District rose on Standing Order 34 (Points of Order) and informed the House about the mining sector. He pleaded to Mr. Speaker for the House to devote a whole day to debate issues covering the mining sector. He reminded the House about the request that he and the Leader of Government Business made about further discussion and more information on the area survey. He pleaded to Mr. Speaker to call upon the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources together with the National Mineral Agency (NMA).

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, responded that they had already decided to set aside time to debate the report that had been laid by the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Mines and Mineral Resources immediately after the closure of the debate on the Presidential Address. He, further, reminded the House about the submission made by the Chairman of Parliamentary Committee on Mines and Mineral Resources

Response by the Leader of Government Business:

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**, reminded the House about the report of the sub-committee dealing with the pollution of the Taia River. He informed the House about funds provided to Sessional Select Committees to perform oversight functions upon which reports had not yet been submitted and stated that all Chairmen found themselves in that category were doing it at their own peril. He gave an ultimatum of one week to all Chairmen that had not submitted their reports to do so before the announcement of the Sessional Select Committees for the Fourth Session of the Fifth Parliament.
