1. Prayers were read by **Mr. Anthony C. Kamara (Principal Table Clerk)**.

2. **Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2021:**

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2021** was moved by **Hon. Brima Mansaray of Constituency 017, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams- Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and adopted by the House.

3. **Mr. Speaker's Announcement:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** informed the House about the outcome of the invitation of the National Coordinator of NaCOVERC. He told the House that they arrived at the conclusion that the number plates of Hon. Members of Parliament should serve as their passes in lieu of the E-Passes that were proposed by NaCOVERC. He told Hon. Members that they were entitled to two other people in their vehicles. He also said that NaCOVERC was insisting that Hon. Members should undergo the test. He told the House that he himself had subjected to the test. He craved the indulgence of all Hon. Members as law makers to undergo the test.

**The Chief Whip of Government Business:**

The Chief Whip of Government Business, **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** thanked Mr. Speaker and supported Mr. Speaker's point of all Hon. Members to undergo the test. He said that his only problem was the delay in releasing the result of the test.

**Mr. Speaker's Response:**

The Principal Table Clerk, **Mr. Anthony C. Kamara**, pronounced that the motion had been approved.

**Mr. Speaker’s Felicitations:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** extended his felicitations to the newly approved presidential nominees and wished them well in their respective appointments.

**8. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):**

**The following Honourable Members rose on S.O. 23:**

- (i) The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District**, informed the House that he was shocked when he read about the first shipment of iron ore by King Hu Mining. He said there was no way to ship iron ore without having an agreement ratified by the House. He referred the House to Section 40 in line with Section 110 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). He urged Mr. Speaker to invite the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources for a much better explanation to Hon. Members. He asked for all shipments to be stopped until they had an agreement ratified by the House.
- (ii) The Chief Whip of Opposition, **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District**, informed the House about the shortage of local currency in the banks. He pleaded to Mr. Speaker to invite the Governor of the Bank of Sierra Leone to the House in order to proffer a much better explanation on the said issue.
- (iii) **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara of Constituency 059, Kambia District** informed the House about the news taking rounds on social media about the withdrawals by the Office of the First Lady. He asked the House to invite the Governor of the Bank of Sierra Leone together with the staff of the Ministry of Finance to the House to proffer much better explanations about those withdrawals.
