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1. **Prayers were read Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk).**
2. **Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):**
The suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:35 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Brima Mansaray of Constituency 017, Kenema District** for the commencement of Proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District** and approved by the House.
3. **Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 17th December, 2020:**
The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Thursday 17th December, 2020** was moved by **Hon. Simeon Fefegula of Constituency 096, Moyamba District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and adopted by the House.

Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, thanked Hon. Members of Parliament for being punctual for plenary sitting. He hoped that the punctuality of Hon. Members would be perpetual.

4. **Swearing in of Elected Members of Parliament (Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone):**

Pursuant to the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991), the Rt. Hon. Speaker (**Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**) called on the Clerk of Parliament to administer the Oath of office to the Newly Elected Members of Parliament as orderly mentioned below:

The aforementioned Elected Members of Parliament took and subscribed the Oath of Office as enshrined in the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) administered by the Clerk of Parliament, **Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally**. It was followed by the presentation of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991), the Standing Orders of Parliament and the Record of Votes and Proceedings. On behalf of Mr. Speaker, The Leadership, Hon. Members and Staff of Parliament, **Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally** presented the newly elected Members of Parliament with Christmas Cards and wished them well.



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Mr. Speaker's Welcoming Address:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, extended a warm and hearty welcome to **Hon. Kadijatu Davies of Constituency 110, Western Rural District**. He said that her return to Parliament was a real formation that proved democracy was taking a deeper and firmer root in the soil of Sierra Leone. He stated that her absence in Parliament was not due to her fault and that her constituents had indicated her presence back to Parliament.

He also extended a very warm welcome to **Hon. Habib Fabba Kaifa of Constituency 078, Bo District** who was a very new Member of Parliament. He admonished the newly-sworn Hon. Member by saying that his constituents had imposed their confidence and trust in him and he hoped that the Hon. Member would not let his constituents down.

Once again, he welcomed both Hon. Members to Parliament and stated that "May God bless them."

B. The Leader of Government Business:

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**, laid the following paper:

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Privileges for Members of Parliament:

Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 032, Bombali District rose on Standing Order 26 in tandem with Section 74 (4) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). The Hon. Member reminded the House about a meeting that was held in Committee Room No. 1 in October regarding to salaries, allowances, gratuities, pensions etc. for the Speaker and Members of Parliament. He said that Hon. Members were all aware of the position of Parliament during that meeting. He also said that Members of Parliament received two papers that were signed by the Speaker of Parliament which actualized the first and second schedule. He then cited Section 74 (4) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone and asked the House to look at the conditions of service for Hon. Members of Parliament regarding to the mandate of the House as provided in the cited Section.

C. The Minister of Trade and Industry:

The Minister of Trade and Industry, **Dr. Edward Hinga Sandi**, laid the following paper:

Agreement for Scanning and Inspection Services between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone (GOSL) and Integrated Trade Services (SL) Limited (ITS) ("The Service Provider"), dated October 2020.

The Leader of Opposition:

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District** reminded the House that he earlier brought up the issue concerning the document that was laid by the Minister of Trade and Industry. He said that the Minister of Trade promised to comply within two weeks but it had been over a month before he fulfilled his promise to Parliament. He also said that it remained another document regarding "tracking" which ought to be laid by the Minister of Transport and Aviation. He asked the Minister of Trade and Industry to convey the message to the Minister of Transport and Aviation so that the other document regarding "tracking" would also be laid before Parliament.
