XVII. ORDER BY MR. SPEAKER

With regards the motion moved by **Hon. Mohamed Sheriff Kasim-Carew**, the Acting Speaker advised that Parliament address the issue on Tuesday, 15th January, 2019, and meantime ordered the Clerk of Parliament to issue a letter to all stakeholders to suspend all auction activities of Government's asset at the Queen Elizabeth II Quay.

5. Hon. Sahr Charles – The Hon. Member further commented on the issue of the withdrawal of security personnel from the former V.P. Chief Alhaji Samuel Sam-Sumana.

XVIII. ORDER BY MR. SPEAKER

The Acting Speaker ordered that the Inspector-General of Police appear before the Parliamentary Committee on Internal Affairs on the issue of security personnel to the former V.P. Chief Alhaji Samuel Sam-Sumana and for the Committee to submit a report at plenary.

6. Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara of Constituency 059, Kambia District – On behalf of His Constituency and the Government of Sierra Leone and the Ministry of Education extended his thanks and appreciation to Mr. Robin Van Persie, current football player of Feyenoord Rotterdam club, who has never been to Sierra Leone and also the ***Sunday Foundation*** for supporting schools in his constituency like Robisong Village especially.

7. Hon. Mohamed Bangura of Constituency 066, Karene District – Requested the provision of security personnel for Members of Parliament.

8. Hon. Peter Musa Moigua of Constituency 011, Kenema District – Raised concern over the use of S.O. 23 (This was over ruled by the Speaker).

9. Hon. Josephine Makieu of Constituency 014, Kenema District – That she had constructed a primary school and a periodic market in her constituency.

10. Hon. Abdul Kargbo of Constituency 077, Port Loko District – He raised concern over the excessive dismissal of personnel at the Sierra Leone Airport Authority and the inappropriate method of recruitment, based on political affiliation. He also mentioned that some Members of Parliament issued press releases to their

With regards concern raised by Hon. **Rtd. Capt. Kanjia Maada Hafiju**, the Acting Speaker stated that the matter should be reported to the Inspector – General of Police during his session with the Committee on Internal Affairs and the outcome should also be reported to the House.
