**STANDING ORDER (S.O.) 23**

**Hon. Patricia Umu Dancay-Bangura** – Informed the House of a disaster that took place in her constituency which caused a lot of damage to homes and displacement of her people. She pleaded for aid to her constituents.

**Hon. P.C. Sanka Bai Kurr Kanagbaro III**

Raised concern over food stuffs sold especially in super-markets without english labels. Most of them he said, are labeled in other languages which cannot be read by Sierra Leoneans, especially the expiring dates of food we consume directly. He called on the Health Committee and the Ministry of Health and Sanitation to take immediate action, so that the inspectors responsible for food stuffs sold in the markets would do thorough inspection for the safety of the people.

**Hon. Hannah Songowa Bundu** – expressed her sincere thanks and appreciation to the Speaker, the Leadership and Members of Parliament for their support in the successful launching of the Parliamentary Action Plan on violence against Women and girls. She pleaded for the full support of Members, towards the implementation of the Parliamentary Action Plan.
