**V. CORRECTION AND ADOPTION OF VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS FOR THE PARLIAMENTARY SITTINGS HELD ON THURSDAY 3RD MAY, 2012:**

**VI. BILL:**

The Legal Aid Act, 2012.

**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING:**

The Deputy Minister of Justice read the Bill for the first time and it was unanimously accepted by Members.

**SECOND READING:**

The Deputy Minister presented the Bill to Members of Parliament.

The Bill was read the second time and was unanimously accepted by Members.

**COMMITTEE STAGE:**

The following amendments were made:

1. Under Definition - The words " in court" were added after the word "representation" to read thus - "legal representation" means a representation in court by a legal practitioner or pupil barrister.
2. Clause 30(2): the word "that" replaced the word "they" in sub clause 2 (a) and (b) to read thus:
  - (a) university law clinics that are affiliated with the Judicial and Legal Training Institute; or
  - (b) paralegals that have been certified as having gone through the appropriate courses at the Judicial and Legal Training Institute or any other appropriate institution approved by the Board.

The Bill went through the Committee Stage with few amendments.

**THIRD READING AND PASSAGE INTO LAW:**

The Bill was read the third time and unanimously passed into law.

**STANDING ORDER (S.O. 23):**

The following Honourable Members stood on S.O. 23 :

1. **Hon. Eric B. Jumu** - Observed that very little learning was taking place in schools in Bo, due to the non availability of chalk caused by the delay in getting their subsidies;

Thirdly, that the editing from the SLBC concerning activities in Parliament produced very brief reports and some important statements were even deleted.
