3. **Hon. Jusufu B. Mansaray** - Regrettably informed the House that Bo City was without Electricity for 5 months and pleaded with the Chairman of Energy Committee to look into the matter;
4. **Hon. Dr Brima M. Kamanda** - Informed Parliament that the provision for S.O. 23 was for Members of Parliament to bring important issues for the attention of the House and should be none controversial.
In the light of this, the Honourable Member informed the House that a Bye Election was conducted in the Eastern Part of Freetown, won by the SLPP

Candidate, and accordingly declared by NEC on the 26th January, 2012, infavour of the SLPP Candidate. Unfortunately the winner had not been sworn in up to the time he was speaking and was unable to start work and address the needs and concerns of the people in that ward. This was clearly depriving the people of their representation.

5. **Hon. Frank Kposowa** - Thanked Mr Speaker for the number of interventions from both the Media and Civil Society for consideration of the FOI Bill. He called on Members of Parliament to consider that Bill.
6. **Hon. Ansumana J. Kaikai** - Right of way to State Avenue, that some Members of Parliament are accorded the privileges while others are not.
7. **Hon. Bliss Osho-Williams** - on a point of clarification.
